Prayer Needed for Children and Families Worker Grant Application - preparations continue apace for this appointment with the post-holder to be employed and managed by our church with a ministry emphasis on our church and town but with opportunities to minister elsewhere in our Circuit.

The next challenge is our application for substantial grant funding from the District.
